



## Da ! Heard It Records, a net-label with eclectic music

Da ! Heard it Records, created in 2006, is a net-label touching on Toyz-Pop, Electro Trash, Chiptune, Breakcore and Electro Punk among others, with a heavy leaning towards 8-bit music (through the use of sounds generated by computers and consoles now considered outmoded) and pixel/net art (visual and digital arts).

The aim of this eclectic record company is to promote new artists and new types of music. DIHR is an outward-looking label, accessible to professional and amateur musicians alike, and to all types of listener, thanks to its policy of open and free culture and to the types of music it publishes.

Its albums are distributed under a Creative Commons licence, encouraging sharing and reuse of the music.

To date, it has released nine albums attesting to its musical diversity and created by such artists as Ben and Bené <http://www.benebene.net>, Computer Truck <http://computertruck.parishq.net>, Sidabitball <http://www.sidabitball.com> and Sputnik Booster <http://www.sputnik-booster.de>; these albums are available at <http://www.daheardit-records.net>.

DIHR continues along this line, reaffirming once more its broad tastes and its auditory curiosity with the signing of [Guÿôm], Le Chien Violet and numerous other artists.
